

"Feasting on the Word" is a lunchtime study that will begin on Thursday, November 5 and last for six weeks (excluding Thanksgiving Day). The study will focus on Friendship in the Christian Life, considering examples of friendship in the Scriptures and the role of friendship in Christian discipleship.
